BMOS Youtheatre was established in 1987 and performs two shows a year in professional theatres in and around Birmingham.

Rehearsals are held Sunday mornings from 10.00am – 12:30pm and Monday evenings from 7.00pm – 9.00pm at Ladywood Arts and Leisure Centre, 316 Monument Road, Ladywood, Birmingham B16 8TR.

Membership is subject to an audition where you will be asked to sing a verse or two from a song and read a few lines from a poem. This could be a nursery rhyme, favourite poem or a song from a show. If you have sheet music or a backing tape, please bring this along to your audition.

BMOS Youtheatre perform to a very professional standard and although the emphasis is on fun and enjoyment, we are not a youth club and therefore require members to act in a disciplined manner whilst at rehearsals. In return we undertake to teach members various stagecraft skills such as vocal training, voice projection, good characterisation, movement and dance.

### Show Fees

These currently stand at £95 per show. £85 per show if there are two or more children from the same family. As this charge alone does not begin to cover the cost of staging two shows per year, it is essential that each member of the society fulfils their ticket sales requirement, these currently stand at 20 tickets per show, otherwise the following ticket levy will apply.

## **FEES**

£95.00 per show, or £85 per show if two or more children are from the same family and they can be paid in 3 instalments (*This is reviewed annually*)

**Members will only be allowed to audition for principal parts in the shows if this has been paid.**

## **PARENTAL HELP**

It is a requirement of the society that during the week of the show parents undertake to help for at least one performance. This could be with Props or stage crew, as a dressing room assistant, chaperoning (with appropriate approvals) or programme selling at the front of house.

Details are available from any committee member.

## **TICKET SALES**

Members are required to sell at least 20 tickets per show (30 if there are two or more children from the same family).

Ticket prices generally range from £10.00 - £15.00.

## **TICKET LEVIES**

The following ticket levies will be applied on a per show basis if the required numbers of tickets have not been sold:

20-29 tickets sold:	£25
12-19 tickets sold:	£50
